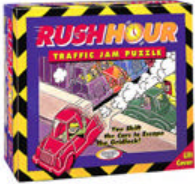


# Parking Deck

game, the simple goal is to get the red car out of the grid, by sliding other cars and trucks forward or backward out of the way. It comes

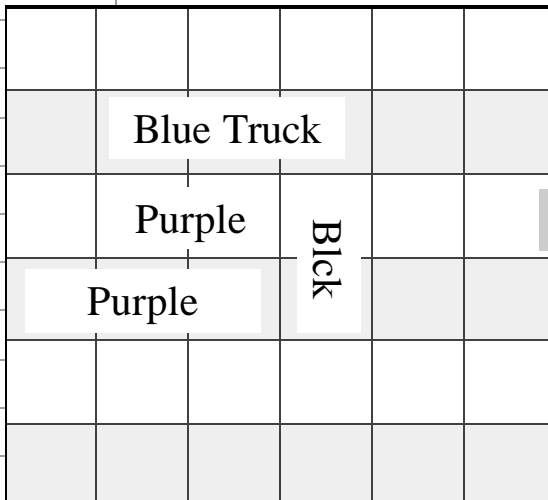
with many cards and I believe now has an expansion (or 10) for more fun.

Unfortunately only the easy set is simple enough for my kids right now (don't worry they are getting better) and that limits us to 10 different options.

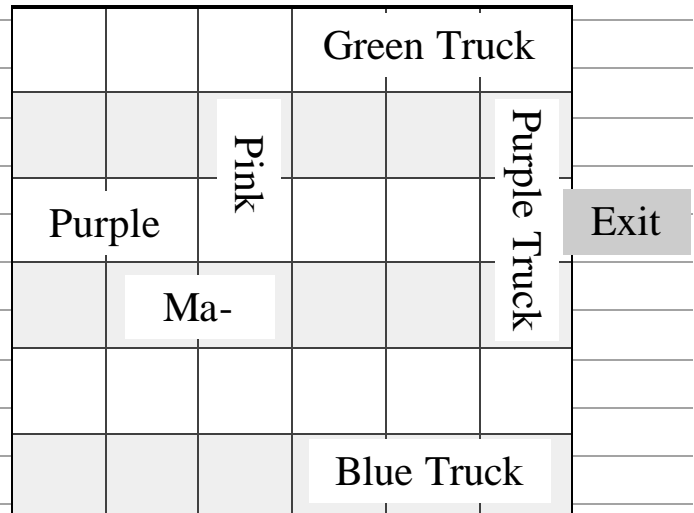
Until, that is, they started coming up with their own! At first it was simply them placing the cars and trucks on the grid for each other or Mommy to figure out, but I thought we could put some on a
